FOOTPRINTS OF THE ABSHIER FAMILY FROM LOUISIANA TO TEXAS

PART TWO

BENJAMIN ABSHIRE, SR was born, according to official "Certificate of Baptism" on record at ST. MARTIN OF TOURS CATHOLIC CHURCH, ST. MARTINVILLE, LA., on June 20, 1788. He was baptized Aug. 3, 1788. This Certificate of Baptism lists BENJAMIN'S PARENTS as: JEAN(JOHN) ABSHIRE, SR. and wife, FRANCISCA(FRANCES, FANNY) HARGRAVES. JEAN(JOHN), SR. was born in Pennsylvania and his parents were from Germany. FRANCES HARGRAVES was born in Brunswick Co., Va., of English parents.

According to the Marriage Index Book A, 1780-1800 of St. Martin Parish Court House Recrods, BENJAMIN ABSHIRE, SR married HANNAH WEED in 1808. Other records on file show that JOSEPH WEED or JOEL WEED (WADE) and wife, MARGARET (PEGGY) GWALT-NEY are the parents of HANNAH WEED, b. July 8, 1792 in Louisiana.

JOSEPH (JOEL) WEED came to Natchez, Mississippi District shortly after the Revolutionary War. We do not know whether he married in Surrey County or Isle of Wight County, Va. This section of Va. was the home base of the GWALTNEYS.

The GWALTNEYS were in Surrey Co., Va., in 1666. THOMAS GWALTNEY at the age of 22 years came over on the "FAULCON" out of London, England in April, 1635. This establishes his birthdate about 1613.

JOSEPH (JOEL) WEED is a descendant of the WEED family of Conneticut. Here is

a quote of an article about his ancestors.

"JONAS WEED, born in England about 1605 came to America in a fleet with SIR RICHARD SALTONSTALL and GOVENOR WINTHROP in 1630. He first settled in WATERTOWN, MASS. where he was made a FREEMAN, May 18, 1631. He removed to WETHERSFIELD, CONN. and again in 1635, he removed to STANFORD, CONN., where he died in 1676. He married MARY , who died in 1690. Children of JOSEPH

STAFFORD, CONN. was the home base of the WEED FAMILY and from this family most of the WEEDS in America descended."

The name ABSHIER has had many spellings; ABSHIRE, ABSHER, ABCHER, ABSHEAR, and HABSHER. As far as we know the original name was spelled ABSHIRE but those who came to Texas adopted ABSHIER, so practically all records in PART TWO will be spelled ABSHIER.

Right after BENJAMIN ABSHIER, SR. and HANNAH WEED were married, he and his brother, JOHN ABSHIER, JR. as well as their parents, JOHN ABSHIRE, SR. and wife, FANNY HARGRAVES, and the rest of the children moved to OPELOUSAS DISTRICT and are listed in the Census Records of St. Landry Parish, La., for 1810.

were neighbors of REUBIN and VINCENT BARROW and their families. REUBIN and VINCENT BARROW moved to Texas in the early 1830's, so when BENJAMIN ABSHIER and his clan moved to Texas in 1843, they settled in the same vicinity of Liberty Co., that the BARROWS had settled. This was around Turtle Bayou near the community of HANKAMER, TX.

JOHN ABSHIRE, SR. died shortly after 1810. FANNIE HARGRAVES ABSHIER and the younger children moved back to St. Martin Parish where they were living in 1820. BENJAMIN, SR., ISAAC ABSHIER and their families all moved back to St. Martin Parish, La. They lived in this vicinity until 1843 when they moved to Texas. JOHN, JR., ABRAHAM and JACOB remained in St. Martin Parish with their mother and families. This, later, became Lafayette, then Vermillion Parish, which is now the home base for our LOUISIANA ABSHIRES.

The U.S. Census of 1840 of St. Landry Parish, La. lists all of BENJAMIN and HANNAH'S children along with their families as living very close to Mermentau, except the youngest daughter, LUCINDA ABSHIRE, who had just married CALEB HIGGIN-BOTHEM. In 1839 they were visiting his people in Jackson, La.

When BENJAMIN ABSHIER, SR. and his entire family came to Texas they brought with them HANNAH'S brother, BENJAMIN WEED and his wife, SARAH HANKS, and their children. The JAMES CALVIN MOOR family stopped off in Jefferson Co., Tx. while ASA JESSE ABSHIER and his family settled at Clear Creek Community, Galveston Co., Tex. BENJAMIN, SR., his two sons, BENJAMIN, JR. and AUSTIN, with their families, BENJAMIN'S sons-in-law, JOHN FOWLER and ALFRED LEE and their families all settled in Liberty Co., Tx. These locations became home base for the ABSHIERS in Texas.

Due to the fact that the Liberty Co. Records were destroyed when the Court House burned in 1874, our early land records are difficult to find. The towns of Liberty, Devers, Hankamer, Dayton, Hardin, Hull, Turtle Bayou, the "Hill" as Daisetta was called at this time and Anahuac were early stomping grounds of these early families.

The ABSHIER CEMETERY is just off Hwy. 61 about eight miles S. of Devers and one mile W. of Hwy. 61. The BARROW and BROWN CEMETERIES are near Hankamer, Tex. The SAHARA CEMETERY is about four miles SE of Devers, the CITY CEMETERY in Liberty, the "OLD FRENCH CEMETERY" NE of Dayton on the Kenefick Road, the LINNEY CEMETERY in Dayton, the OLD ABSHIER CEMETERY E. of Moss Hill and the OAKDALE CEMETERY SE of Daisetta along with many family cemeteries, all are final resting places for many generations of our ABSHIER KIN.

The ABSHIERS, WEEDS, MOORS, FOWLERS, LEES, HIGGINBOTHEMS, BROWNS, BARROWS, WHITES, TAYLORS, LENORMANDS, REAVISES, HARMONS, STENGLERS, WEAVERS, PRUETTS, LINNEYS, BAILLIOS, GREENS, WATSONS, DAVISES, PALMERS, CARRS, FABRIQUIZES, WHITTINGTONS, and many others stand together to make their mark in this history of our family in Texas.

A memo from the diary of WILLIAM FAIRFAX GRAY tells about his trip from Virginia to Texas and back to Virginia in 1835-36. He had a visit with ASA ABSHIER, spelled ABSHEAR, who lived in Louisiana at this time.

"THURSDAY, April 28, 1836, At night we got to ABSHEARS. 18 miles, where I did my best to dry my things. FRIDAY, April 29, 1836 About 3 o'clock, it being fair, I started with ASA ABSHEAR for my guide, we encountered a very heavy shower of rain, but I only got my boots wet. In a pond of water in the prairie I discovered an alligator about six feet long, which I rode up close enough to shoot with my pistol. Arrived after dark at the house of a herdsman, a Spanish Creole, named SEBASTIAN NUMEZ, where we were kindly treated.

These herdsmen live very simple and apparently lives. They have little intercourse with the world, very little learning, no ambition, and have a ball every Saturday night. SEABASTIAN NUMEZ and ASA ABSHEAR are both going to a ball to-morrow night."

On Saturday he left NUMEZ'S house and paid ASA ABSHEAR \$1.25 for being his guide. Notes: ASA was not quite 19 years old at the time. Even the Colonel Grey probably did not know it, SEABASTIAN NUMEZ and ASA ABSHEAR were kin thru their HARGRAVES shown earlier. He also did not know that going to balls on Saturday night was a Cajun custom of which my people were well endowed with.

HERE ARE COPIES OF OLD FAMILY RECORDS.

Herewith is the Military Record of BENJAMIN ABSHIRE, SR. from the War of 1812. Also, his Bounty Land Certificate.

STATE OF TEXAS LIBERTY COUNTY

On this 26th day of March AD 1855, personally appeared before me a, C. BRYAN, Justice of Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid BEN-JAMIN ABSHIER, aged sixty six years who being duly sworn according to law declares that he is the identical, BENJAMIN ABSHIER who was a Private in the Company Commanded by CAPT. SHADRACK PORTER, (in the La. Militia) in the War declared by the United States against Great Britain on the 18th of June 1812, that he was draughted at or on about the day of for the term of three months and continued in actual service in said War for the term of three months and was honorable discharged at New Orleans on the day of AD on account of expiration of service as will appear by the muster roll of said Company-that he never received a written discharge-

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the BOUNTY LAND to which he may be entitled under the "ACT granting additional BOUNTY LAND to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the UNITED STATES, approved March 3, 1855, and refers to his former declaration made under Act of 28th Sept. 1850, upon which he received a Land Warrant No.______ for Forty Acres, which he having legally transferred and disposed of, is not within his power now to return. He further declares that he has not received a warrant for BOUNTY LAND under any other act of Congress, nor made any application therefor, than the one above referred to, under Act of 28th Sept. 1850 upon which he obtained the said Land Warrant No ______ for Forty Acres, and the one now presented.

Sworn to and subscribed before me that day and year above written, and I hereby certify that I believe that said BENJAMIN ABSHER who signed and executed the above declaration and is now present, to be the identical man, who served as aforesaid and that he is the age above stated and that I have no interest in said claim.

He came to Texas early and served in the Army of the Republic of Texas as First Lieutenant in the Fifteenth Infantry. He settled in Liberty Co. in the late 1840's and married FANNIE FOWLER. JAMES B. REAVIS died between the birth of his last son, JEFFERSON DAVID REAVIS in 1861 and the taking of the 1870

Census. There is no mention of him in these records and FANNIE FOWLER REAVIS is listed as the head of the family. Both are buried in undated graves in the Abshier Cemetery off Hwy. 61, south of Devers, Tex., beside their three children who died young; JOHN M REAVIS, MARIE ZELPHIA REAVIS and BENJAMIN FRANKLIN REAVIS.

JAMES BLOUNT REAVIS was a schoolteacher and Court Reporter, often carrying important court records and other papers to Austin, Tex. (Capitol) in the saddle-bags, as his only transporation was on horseback.

Following is a brief summary from the book, THE REAVIS FAMILY IN AMERICA SINCE 1700 by ELMO REAVIS, material found in the North Carolina State Library, Raleigh, N.C.

THE REAVIS FAMILY IN AMERICA SINCE 1700

Being the descendants of EDWARD REAVIS, immigrant from England, who settled on the James River in the Colony of Virginia, became a planter, and there reared seven sons and several daughters.

This particular branch of the REAVIS family, written by FENTON GOSS REAVIS, my grandfather, in about the year 1888. That manuscript mentions about 150 individuals and professes to record the beginning of the REAVIS family in Virginia, so far as recollections of that event had been handed down to FENTON GOSS REAVIS from his grandfather, DAVID REAVIS of NORTH CAROLINA and MISSOURI.

APPENDIX No. 3

ANTHONY ASHLEY COOPER, EARL OF SHAFTESBURY

As a concession to members of the REAVIS Family who have thought(perhaps merely hoped) that EDWARD REAVIS was closely related to the First Earl (1621-1687) by reason of the name ASHLEY, we offer the following observations:

We may well begin with the fact that the First Earl died a harried refugee in Holland, at about the probably time when EDWARD REAVIS was born. This timing, aside from the well authenticated public record of the Earl's known family, makes it wholly improbable that EDWARD REAVIS was the Earl's son. Considering the probable time of EDWARD'S birth, it would be more reasonable to suppose EDWARD REAVIS to have been a son of the Second Earl, who lived from 1652 to 1699, But--

Like his father, the Second Earl was really a Cooper and not an Ashley. EDWARD REAVIS, if actually born an Ashley, could not have been nearer to these Coopers than a collateral relative, and that through the Second Earl's mother, who was the Ashley of the family.

When young JOHN COOPER (later Sir John) in the year 1620 married ANNE, daugher of SIR ANTHONY ASHLEY of Wimborne St. Giles (England), he was marrying into a family which was more ancient and distinguished than his own, but lacked a son to inherit its title and dignities. It was therefore agreed that the offspring of this union should bear the dual name ASHLEY-COOPER, with the maternal grandfather, SIR ANTHONY ASHLEY standing as godfather.

The title Earl of Shaftesbury had no original connection with either name, ASHLEY or COOPER, but was bestowed late in the life of its recepient by his sovereign as recognition and reward for public services rendered (in 1672, before he fell into royal disfavor).

At the time of Sir John's marriage in 1620, there had been COOPERS of social standing in England for some three generations, but the ASHLEYS had been "lords of the manor" since before the reign of Edward I(ca. 1300), or therefore during some four centuries. This means that if EDWARD REAVIS was born an ASHLEY in England about the year 1680 (as we believe he was), he was then born into a family that had been multiplying under the name ASHLEY for about four hundred years and that necessarily aldready had many branches besides the particular branch that married into the COOPER family and acquired a title.

Following are a few "explanation" of the change of family name, collected from members of all branches of the family:

SOME SAY THE NAME CHANGED FOR POLITICAL REASONS: "The first REAVIS came from England. He fought a duel and killed a man, but his adversary had more political influence than he did and he was about to be hung, so he fled to America and changed his name." (S.H.A.)

"A man left England in 1662 by the name of ASHLEY to keep from serving in the Army, and changed his name to REAVIS." (B.G.R.)

"A son of LORD ASHLEY fell into disfavor with his family, came to Carolina, was sought by the King's forces, and changed his name to REAVIS." (J.W.R.)

"An Englishman named ASHLEY came to this country, fought in the Revolution, was captured and released on parole; changed his name to REAVIS to re-enlist." (G.W.R.) "Cling to idea that the name being ASHLEY was changed for political reasons." (S.R.C.)

"Name REAVIS originated in North Carolina. Refugee came with ASHLEY COOPER EX-PEDITION, changed his name to REAVIS because of trouble of some sort." (T.H.R.) "Young man by name of ASHLEY who refused to serve in English Army escaped to America and changed his name to REAVIS."(J.F.R.)

"A young man of royal descent, because of some disobedience of the law, skipped over to Carolinas and changed his name from ASHLEY to REAVIS. This is history handed down to me."(C.R.)

SOME SAY THE NAME CHANGED FOR ECONOMIC REASONS: "ASHLEY is our true ancestoral name, that of REAVIS having been adopted by reason of apprenticeship and marriage with a REAVIS family." (J.A.R.)

"Ran away from home and came to America, calling himself REAVIS." (J.F.R.)
"Two brothers named ASHLEY who came from England, in fear of being carried back, changed their name to REAVIS." (I.L.R.)

SOME SAY THE NAME WAS CHANGED FOR UNKNOWN REASONS: "Family is of Scotch-English origin wherein the name ASHLEY of England figures." (J.E.R.)

"My father used to tell me that our real name was ASHLEY, and changed about two hundred years ago." (L.B.R.)

"My understanding from an aunt, now deceased, is that we are descended from LORD ASHLEY of England."

EDWARD REAVIS was born probably about 1680, and at least six of his GRAND-SONS served as soldiers in the Revolution. Those who offer no explanations whatever for the change of family name are on safest ground. Nevertheless there

must have been some reason for the change. And that reason may well have been connected with coming to the Colony as a bound servant under contract to serve a period in payment for his passage, this being a common practice at that period.

At any rate a certain young Englishman, probably a commoner and son of the soil, who appeared in Virginia two and a half centuries ago, there to become one of that Colony's numerous small planters, and the father of a family of seven sons and two or three daughters. Apparently his was a congenial family group; the sons as they married, settled on near-by farms and remained close to their father throughout his long life. Grandsons were the first to break family ties, when they migrated Westward twenty-odd years after their grandfather's death. Then, in each succeding era, REAVIS men and women have kept pace with our country's receding frontier, until now they are distributed from Atlantic to Pacific in a somewhat fan-shaped pattern spread out from North Carolina.

As a people they are peaceble and law-abiding. Politically they differ as do other large families. In religion they are Protestants, as far as is known."

JAMES CALVIN had a keen, alert mind and was a very shrewd and quick-tempered man. He fell in love with his beautiful cousin, who was also a MOOR and lived in Vermont. Both families frowned upon this infatuation because of the close relationship. JAMES, in his high spirited manner, impulsively ran away from home. The story goes to say that he was about 17 or 17 years of age.

JAMES CALVIN and a young companion, set out for the Louisiana Territory to make their fortune. They progressed very well due to the ability of JAMES being able to make friends by his charming manner.

It was a very cold winter and before leaving Vermont, the two young companions had forethought enough to bring their ice skates. They knew they would have frozen streams and rivers to cross. After they had trudged on foot for several days, they came to a sparsely settled stretch of land.

Overcome by fatigue, they sat down to rest and fall asleep. They were rudely awakened by a band of Indians who took them captive.

The boys could not understand the Indians but by their gestures, they thought they were to be killed. JAMES had a way about him that won people almost instantly. He began to act in such a way that must have charmed the Indians, who, after holding a council, made it known to the boys that they were not to be slain but that they would not give them their freedom either.
