Dec. 13, 1828 to JAMES CALVIN MOOR, b. ca. 1797, Chittenden Co., Vermont, d. July 11, 1870, Liberty Co., Tx., both are buried in the Abshier Cemetery off Hwy. 61, south of Devers, Tx.

JAMES CALVIN MOOR is the son of THOMAS MOOR and wife, ELIZABETH JOINER, Authentic Record: 1850, Jefferson Co. Census, p. 404-5, #14, Beaumont, Tx. THOMAS MOOR was the son of JAMES MOOR and wife, ANN _____ of Scotland. A few years earlier, before JAMES CALVIN was born, THOMAS MOOR and wife, ELIZABETH JOINER, came to America from Scotland and settled in Vermont, therefore the MOORS were of pure Scotch blood.

JAMES CALVIN had a keen, alert mind and was a very shrewd and quick-tempered man. He fell in love with his beautiful cousin, who was also a MOOR and lived in Vermont. Both families frowned upon this infatuation because of the close relationship. JAMES, in his high spirited manner, impulsively ran away from home. The story goes to say that he was about 17 or 17 years of age.

JAMES CALVIN and a young companion, set out for the Louisiana Territory to make their fortune. They progressed very well due to the ability of JAMES being able to make friends by his charming manner.

It was a very cold winter and before leaving Vermont, the two young companions had forethought enough to bring their ice skates. They knew they would have frozen streams and rivers to cross. After they had trudged on foot for several days, they came to a sparsely settled stretch of land.

Overcome by fatigue, they sat down to rest and fall asleep. They were rudely awakened by a band of Indians who took them captive.

The boys could not understand the Indians but by their gestures, they thought they were to be killed. JAMES had a way about him that won people almost instantly. He began to act in such a way that must have charmed the Indians, who, after holding a council, made it known to the boys that they were not to be slain but that they would not give them their freedom either.

When the Indians became curious about the ice skates, the boys pretended they could not understand. JAMES and his companion pretended that they were afraid to venture out on the frozen ground and streams. They put on their skates but would fall and roll around in a very clumsy manner, much to the Indians delight.

When the boys decided that the Indians' caution were not so keen and that they were far enough from the Indians to escape, they arose and shot off down the frozen river like an arrow. The Indians were amazed and too confounded to move at first. They ran after the boys, shooting arrows at them. It was a race of life or death, so the boys gave all they had and escaped.

After this encounter, they had learned a lesson and were keenly alert. They finally reached Louisiana where they obtained work and settled.

JAMES CALVIN met and married LAVIN(ELVINA) ABSHIER. They had ten children, the first six were born in Louisiana and the last four were born in Texas after they moved to Liberty Co., Texas.

There have been other stories of hardships and adventures, handed down through family members through the years. Some with slight variations but the story of how they escaped the Indians seems to be the favorite and the one most often related.

THE CARR FAMILY

HUGO CARR, a tailor, came from England to Kingston, Jamaica with an English Colony. He married Nov. 4, 1747 to MARGUERITE HALFAR and both probably died in Jamaica. (MARRIAGE CONTRACTS, ATTAKAPAS POST 1760-1803 by Winston De Ville, OA Book 15, #175, p.22) and Vol. I, pages 53 and 57.

Marriage certificate of JOSEPH CARR and NANCY(WHITE) HARMON lists witnesses as brothers of the bride: WILLIAM WHITE and JESSIE WHITE.

The name CARR has had many spellings on ancient records. It has been spelled KER, KERR, KARR and CARR. There are also two distinct generic families bearing the name.

The English family considers itself French extraction, while the Scotch family is of Anglo-Saxon descent. The Scotch family settled in Scotland in 1300. In the course of history, the CARRS have held the titles of Lord Jedburgh, Marquis of Lothian and Earl of Somerset.

One branch of the CARR family is represented in Texas by descendants of WILLIAM CARR, one of the earliest settlers in Jefferson County. Although the date of his birth is not known, it is thought that he was born in 1795 in Louisiana.

WILLIAM CARR came to Texas with Austin's third colony in 1827. He married in Louisiana to NANCY LEE, and at the time of his arrival in Texas he had three children.

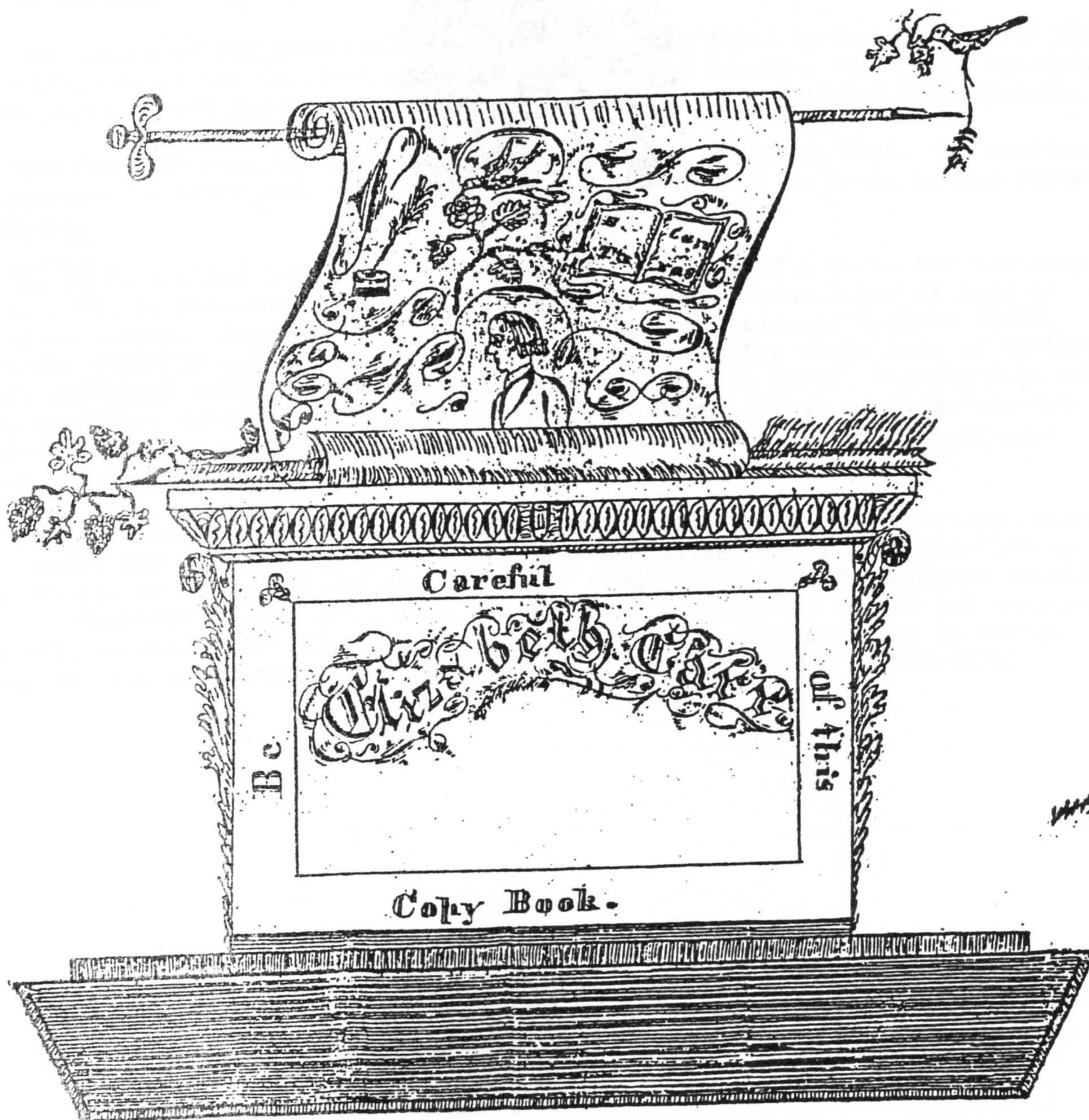
In 1836, WILLIAM CARR received payment for the use of a horse for the Army and in 1846, he received a land grant for one league and one labor of land in Jefferson County. One league(4428 acres) on the north side of TAYLORS BAYOU, JEFFERSON DISTRICT and one labor(177 acres) of land on the south side of TAYLORS BAYOU, JEFFERSON DISTRICT. In 1840 his oldest daughter, NANCY, married E.D. LAW-HORN, the first editor of the first newspaper in Texas. This marriage was one of the earliest in Jefferson County. WILLIAM CARR died at LaBelle, Jefferson County, Tx., March 14, 1874.

He left behind his second wife, CHARLOTTE(HOLST) ENDER, and thirteen children. NANCY LEE of Vermillion, dau. of JAMES and ANNAH LEE, m. WILLIAM CARR in 1819,(NI Ch: OA Folio #76 and SM Ch., V. 6, #126) in SOUTHWEST LOUISIANA RECORDS, Vol. IX(1869-1870), page 437. Also, in marriage information record and census, page 561, we find NANCY LEE listed with two brothers, JOSH and MARK or MARSH. Family records has NANCY listed as a member of the LEE FAMILY of VIRGINIA.

This is the CARR Family COAT OF ARMS, marked
by quarterly first and fourth azure on a
Chevron argent, three mullet, gules, second
and third quarterly gules.



In the early history of our Country, it was proper for the young girls to make a "Copy Book" containing copies of their penmanship for learners to practice or imitate. These were often kept to be used by their children as they practiced penmanship. Following is the front page of ELIZABETH CARR'S "Copy Book." The compiler has the original page framed. Since ELIZABETH CARR was born in 1835 and this book was made in her early school days, we can well assume that the original book is well over 135 years old.

JOHNATHAN(JOHN) HENRY CESSNA came to Texas about 1890 and soon after that his brother, EDWARD(ED) CESSNA came to Texas. Both settled in the Hardin, Tx. area.

The first CESSNAS in America were JOHNATHAN(JOHN) DE CESSNA and wife, PRISCILLA _____, who left France under persecution of the Protestants, going to England and later to America. The CESSNAS were skilled craftsmen and in the textile business. France lost their skills when they left but they played a large part in building up the English textile industry and trade.

JOHN DE CESSNA and wife, PRISCILLA _____ came to America and settled in Pennsylvania. Their descendants moved westward to Ohio, Illinois, the Dakotas, Missouri and Kansas. The "de" was dropped from their name when they came to America.

JOHN DE CESSNA was the father of Major JOHN CESSNA, who served as Major, 1777 of a Volunteer Company, was sheriff of Bedford Co., Pa. and was a member of the

Continental Congress of 1774. Another son, CHARLES CESSNA served as a Major, 1776 in the 2nd Battalion, Bedford, Pa.

DAVID CALHOUN PALMER lived in North Carolina and was first married to a lady named JANE SPRADLEY. They had five children: EMMA(AUNT HUN), THADEUS LEWELLYN(UNCLE BUD): MARY(AUNT SIS) and LAUREN(UNCLE LAUREN) and the fifth child's name is not remembered as he died very young. DAVID CALHOUN PALMER served as a cavalryman in the Confederate Army for the duration of the Civil War. While he was in the army, the Yankees came to his home where his wife and a Negro "Mammy" were living and taking care of the children and trying to take care of property, some horses and cows. The Yankees burned his barn, after taking all the horses for their needs and even took all the cows except the one which the old Negro Mammy had hidden away in the woods so the children could have milk to drink. When DAVID returned from the Army, he found this destruction. The baby(name unknown) and his wife had died. The old Negro Mammy took care of the children after his wife had died. He borrowed an ox-cart, loaded the four children, the Negro Mammy and a few belongings that he could carry with them, plus the old milk cow, tied to the back of the ox-cart, and went to Louisiana. There he met EUPHEMIA MOOR SMITH, the widow of SILAS SMITH. She had two little children, BENJAMIN and LAURA. Her husband, SILAS SMITH, had died in service and she was living alone, taking care of her two children. DAVID CALHOUN PALMER and EUPHEMIA married and traveled with their children to Liberty County, Texas, settling on the open prairie that has since become Hull, Texas.

DAVID CALHOUN and wife, EUPHEMIA, together with a "ready-made" family of six children, began a new start in life on a rented farm with oxen, plows and a few necessities lent by EUPHEMIA'S father, JAMES CALVIN MOOR, who was considered a very prosperous farmer. Everything was made by hand, including clothes made by spinning the thread and weaving the cloth. They would knit socks and stockings

and even dipped and moulded the candles for their light. Every member of the family worked and no one minded the hardships or hard work. Their children, ANGUS, RUPERT, ELLA, LILLIE, LELIA, THETT and DOT were all born on this farm.
