# ASA JESSE ABSHIER, Third Child of BENJAMIN ABSHIER, SR. and HANNAH WEED

ASA JESSE ABSHIER, son of BENJAMIN ABSHIER, SR. and wife, HANNAH WEED, was born Jan. 3, 1816, St. Martin Parish, La., according to the offical "Baptism Certificate". It states that this boy using only the name of JESSE ABSHIER in this Church Record, was born Jan. 3, 1816, and was baptized, April 7, 1816 in ST. MARTIN OF TOURS CATHOLIC CHURCH of St. Martinville, La. This document also states that his parents are: BENJAMIN ABSHIRE, SR. and wife, HANNAH WEED, it further states that his paternal grandparents are: JOHN ABSHIRE and wife, FRANCES(FANNY) HARGRAVES, that his maternal grandparents are: JOSEPH WEED and wife, MARGARET (PEGGY) GWALTNEY.

ASA JESSE ABSHIER was one of the first of the ABSHIRE CLAN that changed the spelling of his last name, from ABSHIRE to ABSHIER. There was also another way, ABSHEAR, which was first noted in the diary of COL. WM. FAIRFAX GREY, who toured Texas from Va. in 1835 and '36 and returned to Va. thru Louisiana via horseback. While he was riding thru the CAJUN COUNTRY of Louisiana, nearing Mermentou on way to the Vermillion, Grey stated that he spent the night at the home of ASA ABSHEAR, hired him as a guide the next day, said ASA invited him to stay until Saturday night and join them at their regular weekly BALL for which the Cajuns were noted. His name was also listed as, ASA ABSHIER, on his marriage record in 1838.

ASA ABSHIER came to Texas in 1843, when his parents, two brothers and four sisters and all of their families came. All of them settled in Liberty Co., Tx., except one sister, LAVINA and her MOOR family, who moved first to Jefferson Co., Tx., but later moved to Liberty about the middle 1850's.

She was the dau. of GEORGE LAUGHLIN and wife,

ASA ABSHIER along with is wife, LUCY ANDRUS, his two daughters, MALINA and LUCINDA came to Texas with the Clan but settled southwest of Liberty Co., in the CLEAR CREEK COMMUNITY, Galveston Co., Tx., where they had three more children, ANDREW JACKSON, MALLISSA ANN, and JAMES ALEXANDER. They lived at CLear Creek Community until Oct. 1, 1850 at which time, ASA and LUCY separated. ASA took the four older children, JAMES not born at the time, and moved to Liberty Co., Tx. where his parents and kindred lived. LUCY remained in the Clear Creek Community, where her son, JAMES ALEXANDER was born.

ASA ABSHIER died Mar. 27, 1892 in Liberty, Tx. and was buried in the City Cemetery, only a short distance from his last home. His birth and death dates were verified from his Bible and other records when orders were given in preparations of making his tombstone at the head of his grave in the ABSHIER plot in the City Cemetery, Liberty, Tx.

ASA ABSHIER obtained license to mary LUCY ANDRUS, Apr. 17, 1838, St. Landry Parish, La., and this was executed Apr. 24, 1838 by Justice CLARK per Bible records. LUCY ANDRUS was born Feb. 12, 1820, St. Landry Parish, La., died May 17, 1882, Waco, Tx., buried in the Oakwood Cemetery, Waco, Tx. She was the daughter of JOSEPH ANDRUS, SR. and wife, HETTY DUNKS.

Herewith is the Marriage Bond and Usual Note attached as custom in St. Landry Parish.

First, the handwritten note addressed to JUDGE KING:

Mr. KING, as it is not convenient that we cannot come and see you ourselves you will be so good as to give, MR. ASA ABSHIER, license to get married to my daughter, LUCY ANDRUS as it is done by my consent and you will be perfectly safe in so doing. Given under my hand this 15th April, 1838.

Signed: HETTY BIGGS, the former wife of JOSEPH ANDRUS, deceased. Also by: JOHN BIGGS

STATE OF LOUISIANA PARISH OF ST. LANDRY

Know all men by these presents, that, ASA ABSHIER and GEORGE LAUGHLIN of the State of Louisiana and Parish of St. Landry, are held firmly bound unto EDWARD D. WHITE, Governor of the aforesaid State, and to his successors in office, in the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS, for the payment of which, well and truly made, they bind themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, They have hereunto signed at Opelousas, this 17th day of April in the year of the Lord, One Thousand and Eight Hundred and Thirty Eight.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above bound, ASA ABSHIER, has this day obtained License to marry, MISS LUCY ANDRUS, of said Parish. Now if there should be or hereafter appear no legal impediment to said marriage then in that case, the above obligation to be null and void otherwise to remain in full force.
